As you may know we have co-produced the organ book that was made as part of Rana's multi-work installation and exhibition The Ten Murders Of Josephine shown at Witte de With in Rotterdam, later staged as a performance at the Rotterdam Schouwburg.

On June 20, Lafayette Anticipations - Fondation d'entreprise Galeries Lafayette, of which I serve as Managing Director, will open its first group exhibition The Centre Cannot Hold, composed of new commissions presented in our newly inaugurated building in the Marais district in Paris. Part of this exhibition will be a presentation of Rana's work, amongst which her organ book. Other artists included in the show are Julien Creuzet, Danielle Dean, Paul Maheke a.o. — all young artists tackling issues related to identity and subjectivity.

Therefore, we would like to offer our support for your future endeavors. As a general interest foundation, we support artists and designers in producing new work. In this capacity we think we can be of assistance, in promoting your book by finding a publisher for a French translation, for instance. We would be happy to engage in finding other possibilities for collaboration.

We hope you accept our offer and look forward to exchanging, as we find a solution in a constructive and positive manner for everyone involved.
